

Pool Rules

1. Pool management reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time.
2. Use the pool at your own risk. The City of Los Alamitos and Los Alamitos Unified School District are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
3. No animals are allowed in the pool area.
4. Eating or drinking is not allowed in the pool or dressing area (water is allowed), glass containers are not permitted within the facility.
5. Smoking is prohibited.
6. Foul and abusive language will not be tolerated.
7. Patrons are not allowed to run within the facility.
8. Patrons are not allowed to dive into shallow water and only can dive in designated areas.
9. Patrons are not allowed to engage in horseplay including but not limited to: wrestling, pushing, splashing, throwing of another person, horseback rides, chicken fights, or prolonged breath holding under water.
10. Patrons may not interfere with a lifeguard during an emergency situation or call for help unless you are in distress.
11. Patrons not participating in swim lessons, lap swim, or open swim must stay on the bleachers and may not wander about the facility.
12. A swim test will be given to all participants who wish to enter the deep end during Recreation/Open Swim.
13. Patrons must shower before entering the pool.
14. The use of cameras, video cameras or any device containing camera equipment of any kind is prohibited in all locker rooms, bathrooms, or changing facilities.
15. The City of Los Alamitos and the Los Alamitos Unified School District is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
16. No patron is allowed to change on the pool deck they must use appropriate facilities.
17. All patrons entering the pool must wear proper swimming attire at all times while in the pool and they must be appropriately covered i.e., no nudity. Please see Aquatics staff if there are questions about swimming attire.
18. Patrons are not allowed to wear street clothes in the pool at any time.
19. All patrons, including children, are expected to be in compliance with all swim attire guidelines.
 - a. Children under the age of 4 without an approved swim diaper are not permitted in the pool.
20. Patrons that are not going to enter the swim area do not need to wear swim attire but must be in appropriate attire.
 - a. Adults who are supervising children less than 5 years old must be in compliance with swim attire guidelines and accompany the children into the water and must remain within arm's reach of the child.
21. The Aquatic staff reserves the right to inspect patrons for proper swim attire prior to entrance and while they are in the facility.
22. The Aquatic staff reserves the right to enforce all rules and regulations to patrons while at the facility.
